Hours, drop off and Pickup:

Our school hours are 8:30 to 3:05. Students arriving between 8:00 and 8:20 should report to the cafeteria. When dropping off students, please remember to use the Main Street entrance (the church double doors) as Huron Street is utilized by the busses. At dismissal, those students riding in a car will proceed to the Main Street entrance (except for Preschool-4). **Please park your vehicle in a marked, non-handicap (unless you have a handicap sticker) parking space for pickup.** Any student not picked up from school by his or her 'car' driver by 3:15pm will be waiting in the school office. If you would like to make other arrangements, please send in a signed note that we can keep on file.

This is a reminder that, by law, all students need to have a copy of immunizations on record in the nurse's office by September 15th. Preschool students also need to have a physical form on file.

If your child needs to take any medication at school whether over the counter or prescription, there is a form that must be completed which is available on the school website as well as in the office. This form must be signed by a doctor in order for any school personnel to administer medication to a student.
