The Brown Envelope: All school information is communicated to you *EVERY THURSDAY* either in the envelope, via email, or sometimes both. Forms, Forms, and More Forms: The beginning of the school year is exciting, but it can be dreadful completing all the forms! Please return the completed forms by Wednesday, September 9th. Many of the forms pertain to medical issues and emergency numbers. Please remember to notify the office whenever there is a change of address or phone number.

From the Nurse: This is a reminder that, by law, all students need to have a copy of immunizations on record in the nurse’s office by September 16th. Preschool students also need to have a physical form on file dated within the past 13 months. If your child needs to take any medication at school whether over the counter or prescription, there is a form that must be completed which is available on the school website as well as in the office. This form must be signed by a doctor in order for any school personnel to administer medication to a student.



Hours, drop off and Pickup: Students arriving between 8:00 and 8:30 should report directly to their homeroom after being temperature checked. When dropping off students, please remember to use the appropriate entrances (all are marked). At dismissal, those car riders will proceed to the Main Street entrance (except for Preschool). **Please park your vehicle in a marked, non-handicap parking space for pickup and wear a mask.** Any student not picked up from school by his or her ‘car’ driver by 3:15 will be waiting in the school office.

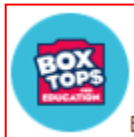


The PTO Wants You to Know:
