
Attendance:

VIRTUS Certification:

Volunteers for the Diocese of Toledo are required to take a safety class known as VIRTUS. VIRTUS is the brand name that identifies best practices programs designed to help prevent wrongdoing and promote "rightdoing" within religious organizations. The VIRTUS programs empower organizations and people to better control risk and improve the lives of all those who interact with the Church. If you are a new family, your email addresses have already been sent to the Parish Office. If you are a returning family that has not taken the VIRTUS certification, please email Laura McCall for instructions.
