Dear Parents and Guardians,

Below please find updated isolation and quarantine procedures from the Erie County Health Department, ODH, and CDC.

In conjunction with Huron City Schools, St. Peter School will use the following procedures for COVID-19:

- Students and staff that test positive for COVID-19 may return to school five days after the onset of symptoms if they are asymptomatic OR symptoms are getting better. For the following five days a mask must be worn.
 - If unable to mask, may return ten days after the onset of symptoms.
- Students and staff exposed to COVID-19 outside of the school setting:
 - Unvaccinated/Partially Vaccinated: may return to school five days after exposure if they are asymptomatic. For the following five days, a mask must be worn.
 - Fully Vaccinated >6 months ago (Moderna & Pfizer) or >2 months ago (J&J): may return to school five days after exposure if they are asymptomatic. For the following five days, a mask must be worn.
 - Boosted, fully vaccinated <6 months ago (Moderna & Pfizer or <2 months ago (J&J), or COVID+ <90 days ago: Wear a mask for ten days after exposure.
 - If unable to mask, may return ten days after exposure.
- Students and staff exposed to COVID-19 within the school setting:
 - Mask for ten days after exposure.
 - If unable to mask, may return ten days after exposure

Parents of students identified as close contacts will be notified by the school.
