### Next Dine to Donate:

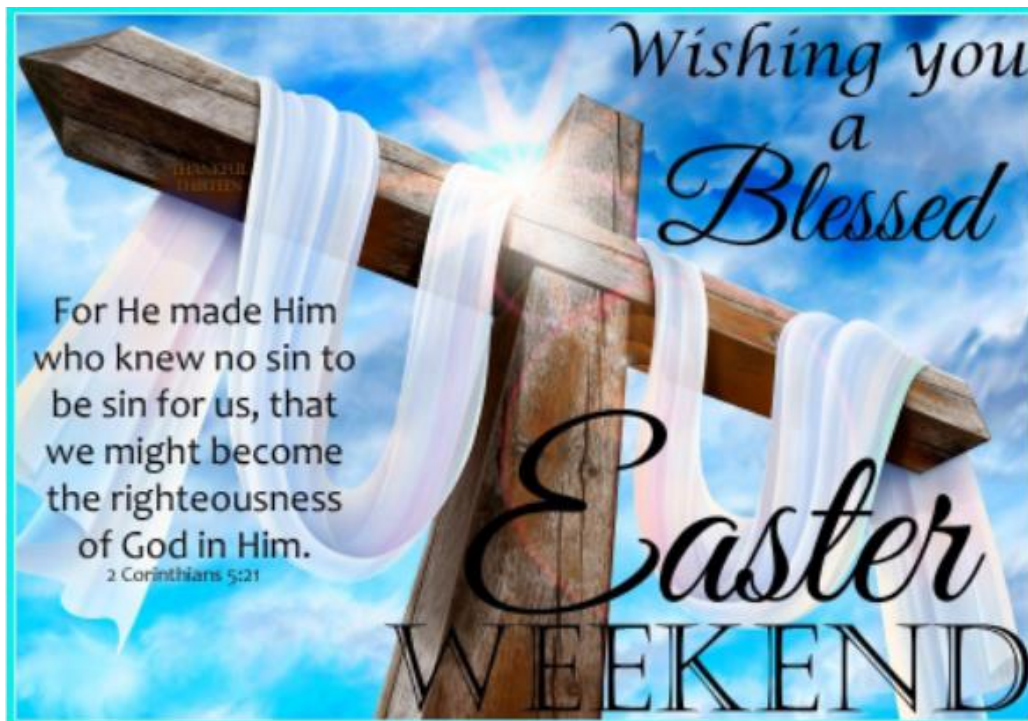
