Through the generosity and kindness of the Jack and Rhodora Donahue Family Foundation of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the Golden Apple Award has been established to honor outstanding individuals who devote their lives to teaching in Catholic schools. The 2022-23 school year marks the eighteenth consecutive year that this prestigious award has been presented in the Diocese of Toledo. The award is given to seven (7) preschool and/or elementary school teachers and two (2) secondary teachers each year. The award consists of a cash award of \$5,000 and a Golden Apple with a 24-carat gold cross.
