Parents be aware that we will begin MAP and ARK testing soon. ARK is the Assessment of Religious Knowledge that all students in grades 2 - 8 take. It is a requirement of the Diocese. MAP is the test that we use to measure student growth and is given in the fall and spring as well as in the winter in some classes. Anytime you would like your student's results or if you would like to have a meeting to discuss their test results please contact me. Although testing takes time, it is also a valuable tool we use to determine how we can best serve each of our students.

Remember that registration for next year is ongoing. Please return your forms to the school office as soon as possible. Preparation has begun for the next school. Returning your Registration Form and deposit secures your place at St. Peters. If your family is not returning, please inform Mrs. Cope or Mrs. Konopka via email or phone call. Our goal is to provide a Catholic Education to every student who desires to attend our school. There are several scholarships and financial aid like EdChoice, Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund and St. Peter's Annual Fund, and Named Family Scholarships available. The EdChoice Information sheet is attached to your email. The Northwest Ohio Scholarship deadline is April 28th and information can be found in the brown envelope. If you selected the Annual and Named Family Scholarships when you returned your registration package, the application is in your brown envelope.

If you know of a new family that is interested in exploring our school, please have them contact Mrs. Cope. If you refer a family who enrolls their student(s) you will be eligible for a \$200.00 credit on your tuition account after the first quarter of the school year.

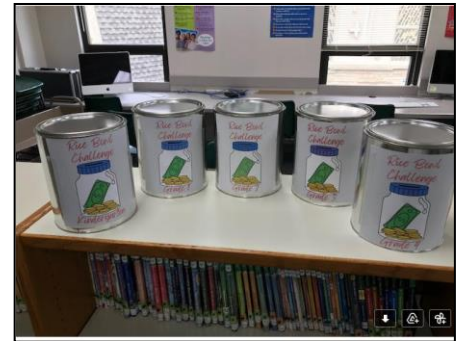
Rice Bowl Classroom Challenge
