Greetings parents! Registration is still open. If you have questions about the upcoming school year or about tuition, please contact me. I would very much welcome conversation about why St. Peter School is the best choice for education in your student. We have plenty of tuition assistance options available to you. Money should never be the reason for your student leaving our school. For those families denied by EdChoice, the next step is the Annual Fund and Named Family Tuition assistance. A tuition assistance application will be sent to those parents that requested it on the Tuition Payment Agreement in the Registration package. For our families that will be making monthly payments for 23-24 tuition, please hold off on setting up next school year's payment plan with FACTS. We are exploring new options which may better serve our families. The decision will be made by the 15<sup>th</sup>.

The students are preparing for Olympic Day and soon will start their Art and Academic Projects. In addition this year, our third and fourth grade students are preparing for their musical Lemonade on the Wednesday March 29th in the Gathering Space. They are looking forward to entertaining you.

There is a lot of chatter in the news lately about some possible changes to EdChoice. I have been following this closely and will make you aware of any changes to the income requirements. There is a possibility that the income percentage may increase. We will have to wait and see what the state legislature decides to do.

This past week I am sure you heard from your student(s) that we are not giving out new Casual Dress slips any longer. If your student has slips that are signed by a teacher, they will be honored. I would like students to bring the slip into the office the day before they dress down so that Mrs. Konopka or I can verify that they will be able to dress casual the next day. I have received many suggestions and know how important this is to students and will be taking those under consideration for next year.

Please pray for our eighth-grade confirmation students as they travel to Rosary Cathedral in Toledo this Saturday for their confirmation Mass. As always take time for your family this weekend and to attend Mass. Also thank you for your support and prayers for our staff and students.
