 - Early Dismissal on the last day of school, Thursday, June 1st at **1:35 pm**. Please make any needed adjustments for your child(ren)
 - If your child(ren) is not returning next fall, please stop by the office to sign a release of records form.

 - Next school year St. Peters will be using **Digital Academy** as its school learning platform and to manage student information. Digital Academy (DA) is where you will go to check student grades and progress, fill out and submit school forms, pay for tuition, lunch balances, and student fees, and communicate with the school staff. Please look for a welcome email in Mid-June for you to set up your account and tuition payment method. The first payment or payment in full is due by July 31, 23. Remember all unpaid balances for 2022-23 tuition and/or for the Lunch Program but be paid in full by June 1. If you have Lunch Account has a credit balance, it will transfer into Digital Academy for the 2023-24 School Year.
